HOT-ICU newsletter – July 2017

The Handling Oxygenation Targets in the Intensive Care Unit (HOT-ICU) trial started recruiting patient the 19th of June 2017 at Aalborg University Hospital, Denmark. Within the first week, we included five patients and we are highly satisfied with the progress.

In general, the feedback from intensivists and ICU nurses are very positive and the electronic screening, randomisation and data registration system functions very well.

HOT-ICU trial sites

The trial site in Aalborg will be the only active site during the summer holidays. Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen Unitersity Hospital, Denmark is ready to start inclusion in mid-August followed by several Danish sites late August, September and October. The national primary investigators have started the process of seeking for approval from their national authorities, the first non-Danish site ready for recruiting patients will presumably be the ICU at Oslo University Hospital in Norway.
