

CLASSIC newsletter – July 2019

Dear Friends – THANK YOU for supporting the trial!

Status

Since trial start **213 patients** have been randomised from 16 sites. Mean recruitment per week has increased to 7 patients.





ICU Solna, Sweden, has recruited their first patient. In total, 3 Swedish sites are active In Norway, 3 sites are active



ICU Bern, Switzerland, has joined the trial



ICU Kolding, Hillerød and Aalborg have joined the trial

Future active sites

ICUs at Pilsen (Czech Republic), Barcelona (Spain) and Milan (Italy) are expected to start the trial during the summer. In autumn we are looking forward to welcoming Brussels (Belgium), Helsinki (Finland) and several sites in the UK.

Important information!

- The dataset for the first interim analysis (10%) has been sent to the Data Monitoring and Safety Committee. After their recommendations, we hope to share knowledge with you.
- 1-year follow-up: Please inform patients that you will contact them by phone after 1 year
 with two questionnaires about quality of life and cognitive function (10 min). Assure that you
 have a valid phone number. Each site is responsible for performing the 1-year follow-up for
 their own patients. You will receive more information from Maj-Brit Kjær (see below) about
 the follow-up as we get closer.
- A new protocol update (version 2.3) is soon available. We will send it directly to the primary investigators via e-mail and upload it on the website. Make sure to use the newest protocol version when available.
- Sub-studies on echocardiography and biomarkers in the CLASSIC trial will be conducted by the Swedish team. Contact: Maria Cronhjort, maria.cronhjort@sll.se
