Dear friends – thank you for your contribution in 2020

Almost 75% of the patients have been randomised and we expect to finish inclusion in August 2021. The Covid-19 pandemic affects most trials, including CLASSIC, but the awareness of the trial hasn't ceased. Big thanks for your efforts to move CLASSIC forward!

Status

Since trial start 1122 patients have been randomised by 28 sites in 7 countries.

In the past 2 months we have included on average 7 patients per week and we expect inclusion rate to increase in 2021.
