### Status

Recruitment remains low as expected for the season. Across Europe the BA.4 and BA.5 Omicron variants are on the rise. The impact on hospital admissions remains to be seen, but we urge all participating sites to screen all relevant patients for trial randomisation.

### Recruitment

The 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2022 patient number 680 was randomized at *North Zealand Hospital, Denmark*.

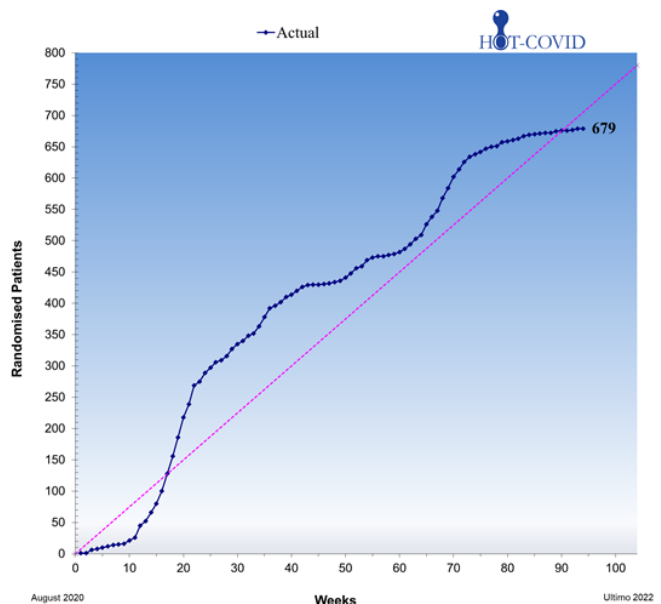
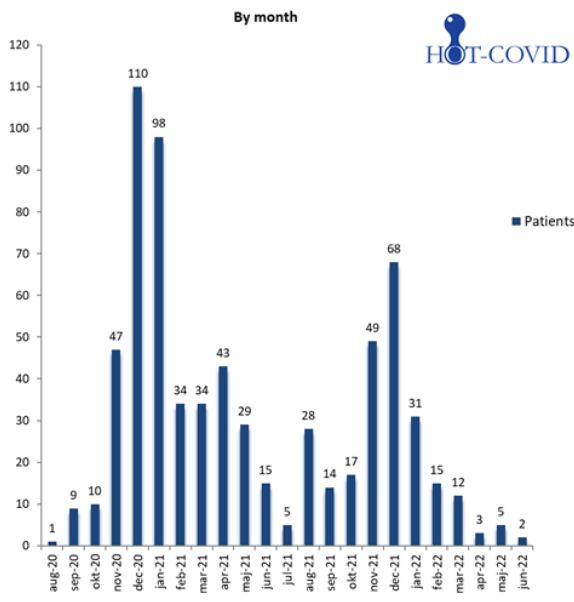
On the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2022 *Zealand University Hospital - Roskilde, Denmark* randomised their first patient in HOT-COVID.

**Currently, only 99 randomizations remain before trial completion.**
