



## AID-ICU trial

### Inclusion criteria

- ✓ Acute (unplanned admission) to the ICU
- ✓ Aged 18 years or above
- ✓ Diagnosed delirium with validated screening tool CAM-ICU or ICDSC

### Exclusion criteria

- ✗ Contraindications to haloperidol: intolerance to haloperidol or additives, known Parkinson's disease or other extrapyramidal symptoms, known QTc prolongation, history of tardive dyskinesia or comatose (non-pharmacological) patients, previous ventricular arrhythmia or torsades de pointes, uncorrected hypokalaemia
- ✗ Habitual treatment with antipsychotic medication
- ✗ Treatment with antipsychotics in the ICU prior to inclusion
- ✗ Permanently incompetent (e.g. dementia, mental retardation)
- ✗ Delirium Assessment non applicable (language barriers, deafness, blindness)
- ✗ Withdrawal from active therapy or brain death
- ✗ Fertile woman (< 50 years) with positive urine human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG) or plasma-hCG
- ✗ Patients with alcohol-induced delirium (delirium tremens)
- ✗ Patients under coercive measures by regulatory authorities
- ✗ Consent unobtainable according to national regulations
