
Dear friends,

Thank you very much for your support and dedication in these challenging times

Status

Since trial start 747 patients have been randomised by 24 sites in 7 countries.

When 777 patients have completed 90 days follow-up, the 3rd and final planned interim analysis will be conducted by the Data Monitoring and Safety Committee. We will announce when we reach 777 patients to ensure complete data by day 90. We're nearly halfway!

1-year follow-up

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Important information

COVID-19

Patients with COVID-19 can be included in CLASSIC if they develop septic shock. Current data suggest that about 20-35% of ICU patients with Covid-19 may develop shock. ¹⁻⁵ When clinical workload allows for it, we hope you will consider including these patients to increase knowledge of fluid therapy in this subgroup.

Consent during COVID-19

As most ICUs have restricted visitation policies, collection of informed consent from relatives will, in Denmark, be collected in the following way (we suggest that international sites use similar methods):

- initial timely contact by phone with oral information
- written information and consent form are sent by e-mail or post
- in case of consent, relatives return consent form by e-mail or post

Tips to minimize protocol violations in CLASSIC

- Are fluids indicated?
- Can sedation be minimized?
- Can other vasodilators be minimized?
- Reduce epidural?
- Lower respiratory pressures?
- Can the fluid be given orally instead?
