


Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!

Many COVID patients develop delirium during their ICU stay and we continue to recruit patients to the trial although we are running fast in our clinical work. New staff are trained in CAM-ICU to keep compliance in the study. We strive to keep trials running along with other CRIC trials focusing on COVID-19 treatments; COVID-STEROID2 and HOT-COVID.


