One case of Tardive Dyskinesia has been reported among trial participants in 2021. The patient that experienced Tardive Dyskinesia was discontinued from trial medication and treated according to local guidelines. One case of extrapyramidal symptoms has been reported among trial participants in 2021. Trial medication was discontinued and symptoms resolved.
